ESCALATION OF HOSTILITIES IN LEBANON

As of 07 October 2024 (Assistance provided since 27 September 2024)

The Humanitarian Country Team in Lebanon, led by the Humanitarian Coordinator and supplementing national efforts, continues to respond to the humanitarian needs of the people affected by the increase in hostilities in Lebanon.

Displacement and Casualties

 **608,509** Displaced*

52% females

Based on the 2006 experience, where only 25% of IDPs were in collective shelters, Lebanese authorities estimate the total number of **Internally Displaced Persons** is over 1 million

 **Collective Shelters****

978 out of which 775 are full.

The ongoing registration now includes more than **180.7K** Internally Displaced Persons
